

U.S. Customs Power of Attorney

With Designation as Export Forwarding Agent & Acknowledgment of Terms and Conditions of Service

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That,

hereby constitutes and appoints **Alpha Customs Brokers USA, Inc.**, **its Officers and duly authorized Employees**, its successors in interest and assigns, and/or specifically authorized agents, to act for and on its behalf as a true and lawful agent and attorney of the Grantor named above for and in the name, place and stead of said Grantor from this date and in ALL U.S. Customs districts and in no other name, either in writing, electronically, or by other authorized means, to:

Make, endorse, sign, declare, or swear to any entry, withdrawal, declaration, certificate, bill of lading, carnet or any other documents required by law or regulation in connection with the importation, transportation, or exportation of any merchandise shipped or consigned by or to said Grantor;

Perform any act or condition which may be required by law or regulation in connection with such merchandise; to receive any merchandise deliverable to said Grantor:

Make endorsements on bills of lading conferring authority to transfer title; to make entry and collect drawback; and to make, sign, declare, or swear to any statement, certificate, or any other affidavit or document which may be required by law or regulation for drawback purposes, regardless of whether such affidavit or document is intended for filing in any Customs district;

Sign, seal, and deliver for and as the act of said Grantor any bond required by law or regulation in connection with the entry or withdrawal of imported merchandise or merchandise exported with or without benefit of drawback, or in connection with the entry, clearance, lading, unlading or navigation of any vessel or other means of conveyance owned or operated by said Grantor, and any and all bonds which may be voluntarily given and accepted under applicable laws and regulations, consignee's and owner's declarations provided for in section 485, Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, or affidavits or statements in connection with the entry of merchandise;

Sign and swear to any document and to perform any act that may be necessary or required by law or regulation in connection with the entering, clearing, lading, unlading, or operation of any vessel or other means of conveyance owned or operated by said Grantor;

Issue powers of attorney on behalf of Grantor to other customs brokers to transact Customs business on behalf of Grantor; to receive, endorse and collect checks issued for Customs duty refunds in Grantor's name drawn on the Treasurer of the United States; if Grantor is a nonresident of the United States, to accept service of process on behalf of Grantor;

And generally to transact Customs business at the customhouses in any district, including making, signing, and filing of claims or protests under section 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930, in which said Grantor is or may be concerned or interested and which may properly be transacted or performed by an agent and attorney, giving to said agent and attorney full power and authority to do anything whatever requisite and necessary to be done in the premises as fully as said Grantor could do if present and acting, hereby ratifying and confirming all that the said agent and attorney shall lawfully do by virtue of these presents.

This power of attorney to remain in full force and effect until revocation in writing is duly given by Grantor and received by Alpha Customs Brokers USA, Inc. If Grantor of this power of attorney is a partnership, said power shall in no case have any force or effect after the expiration of two years from the date of its execution.

Grantor hereby authorizes Alpha Customs Brokers USA, Inc. to provide details of customs transactions to Alpha Logistiques Inc, 7715A Henri Bourassa Ouest, Saint-Laurent, Quebec, Canada, H4S 1P7, and hereby waives the direct receipt of bills for services rendered and/or copies of the customs entries. Grantor authorizes Alpha Customs Brokers USA, Inc. to transmit its bills for services rendered and/or copies of the customs entry documents to Alpha Logistiques Inc.



Appointment as Forwarding Agent: Grantor authorizes Alpha Customs Brokers USA, Inc. to act within the United States as lawful agent and prepare, sign, endorse, and/or file export documents (i.e., shipper's export declaration, commercial invoices, bill of lading, insurance certificates, drafts and any other document) and submit export data electronically through the Automated Export System as necessary for the completion of an export on Grantors behalf as may be required under law and regulation in the United States and to appoint forwarding agents on Grantor's behalf.

If Grantor is a Limited Liability Company, signatory certifies that he/she has full authority to execute this power on behalf of Grantor.

If Grantor is a Partnership, signatory certifies that he/she has full authority to execute this power on behalf of Grantor and shall state the names of all general partners on a separate addendum to this document.

If Grantor is a Limited Partnership, signatory shall also provide a copy of the limited partnership agreement with this power of attorney.

If you are the importer of record, payment to the broker will not relieve you of liability for U.S. Customs charges (duties, taxes, or other debts owed Customs) in the event the charges are not paid by the broker. Therefore, if you pay by check, Customs charges may be paid with a separate check payable to "U.S. Customs & Border Protection" which will be delivered to Customs by the broker. Importers who wish to utilize this procedure must contact our office in advance to arrange timely receipt of duty checks.
